PROGRAMMATIC HIGHLIGHTS



We believe year-round, outdoor play gives children the opportunity to expand their imagination and develop curiosities while promoting gross motor development. Our expansive, fenced playground boasts mature trees, paved bike paths, grass- and woodchipsurfaces and two sandboxes. We also access the nearby wooded area for further investigation of the natural world.

We engage in an active learning process where children investigate a subject of interest. As children develop their curiosity, they begin to problem-solve and learn how to think critically. Teachers support this investigation by offering provocations to support the children's learning as they construct their ideas around this subject.

Child-Directed Play



We utilize developmentally appropriate materials in our classroom environments to facilitate creative expression. and initiate learning in the areas of literacy, numeracy, and science. It is through a child's self-selected play that cooperative social interactions are practiced, and learning becomes meaningful.

We collaborate with experienced early childhood educators who engage children in yoga and breathwork, teaching mindfulness and supporting their development of emotional regulation. Our music program provides opportunities for singing, dancing and an introduction to rhythm instruments.



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
