As a child's first school experience, it is our intention at RNS to inspire a love for learning by providing an environment that supports and honors each child's unique development and interests. At RNS, we believe children learn best through play. When children are free to explore their environment and the materials around them, the learning they acquire is meaningful. It is through this exploration that a child learns about the world in which they live.

Building a strong social and emotional foundation is our primary goal for preparing children for kindergarten and beyond. Our program is deeply rooted in community, and we encourage parent engagement in their child's learning, providing many opportunities for participation year-round.

We are the second oldest preschool in Illinois, and the first in Lake County to be accredited by the National Academy of Early Childhood Programs (NAEYC). We are affiliated with Alliance for Early Childhood Education.

Project-Based Learning



We engage in an active learning process where children investigate a subject of interest. As children develop their curiosity, they begin to problem-solve and learn how to think critically. Teachers support this investigation by offering provocations to support the children's learning as they construct their ideas around this subject.

Weekly Eurichment



We collaborate with experienced early childhood educators who engage children in yoga and breathwork, teaching mindfulness and supporting their development of emotional regulation. Our music program provides opportunities for singing, dancing and an introduction to rhythm instruments.
